District Information

For the 2016-2017 school year Plattsmouth Community Schools has an enrollment of 1,750 students. There is a K-4 elementary school, a 5-8 middle school, and a 9-12 high school. All three schools are Advanced Ed accredited. In addition, there is a Head Start program, preschool program for special needs students, and an Administration Center.

Class Periods

Plattsmouth's school year is divided into two semesters with a total of 176 instructional days. Classes meet every other day for a block for the length of a semester. Each student has eight class periods and one tutorial period. Students earn five credits for the successful completion of most semester courses.
